

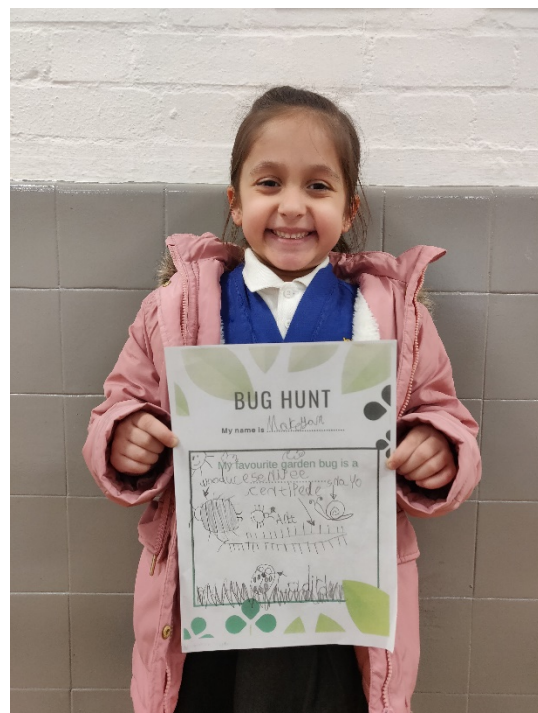
Year One – Gardening Blog
